

**RULES AND REGULATIONS  
FOR DETERMINING THE AMERICAN LEGION DISTRICT SIX LEGIONNAIRES OF  
THE YEAR AWARD**

**RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

**Names may be submitted by:**

- 1. Any Legionnaire whose current dues are paid and who is a member of a Post in District Six.**
- 2. Any Post within the District which has paid Current County and District Dues.**
- 3. The District Executive Committee will serve as the award panel.**

**To be eligible nominees must be:**

- 1. A veteran of military services, or on active duty.**
- 2. Must be honorably discharged.**
- 3. Must be a current paid member of a Post within the confines of District Six.**
- 4. Nomination may be based on services to veterans, the community, for accomplishments over a lifetime or a combination, or heroic effort within the preceding year.**
- 5. Have not been previously awarded this award before.**

**There will be named, for District Six, Dept. of Ohio, Summer Convention, an outstanding veteran, this honor will be limited to no more than one (1) living and one (1) deceased each year. Nominations must be submitted on forms provided by the District Six Executive Committee. The Executive Committee will have these nomination forms at the Spring Conference of each year. Forms will be mailed to the Posts not in attendance at the Conference. All applications for Veteran of the Year must be received by the April District Executive Committee meeting.**

**Those veterans selected will be publicly named on the day of the Summer Convention each year. Recipients will receive his/her name on a plaque. His/her name displayed on a District rotating plaque listing all of the other recipients for display at their Post.**

**As stated the District Six individual veteran may be honored each year receiving recognition for:**

- 1. Service to Veterans**
- 2. Service to the Community**
- 3. Life time accomplishments at the Post, County and District level**
- 4. A heroic deed in which the veteran placed his/her own life in jeopardy, or acted without regard to his/her own safety to aid another person, or a combination of any of all of the above.**
